Preliminary Requirements/Audition Process

Resumes and video recordings must be received by **1 May**. Applicants who are considered qualified for the live audition will be contacted by The USAF Band auditions team and will receive an audition invitation letter. All invited candidates must be prepared to meet Air Force maximum allowable weight standards. Please send a one page resume and preliminary video recording with the requirements listed below. Excerpts can be found in the packet and are marked with brackets.

- 1. Xylophone Porgy and Bess
- 2. Bells The Magic Flute
- 3. Snare drum Scheherazade Mvt. 4 P-U including rests
- 4. Tambourine Carmen Aragonaise

The video must be one continuous shot using a wide angle with the performer in the picture the whole time. Video shot with a smartphone is acceptable as long as there is audio clarity. Please play all 4 excerpts in order without any editing in between. Submit a link to a unlisted YouTube video to the email address below.








The Cadence is to be played while marching using **traditional grip**. Play all rolls open.
