2nd/JAZZ TROMBONE with the AIRMEN OF NOTE

Musical Requirements--The 2nd /jazz trombone position in the Airmen of Note requires a musician who demonstrates the highest level of proficiency as both a soloist and as a section player, performing in multiple styles such as: Swing, Bebop, Brazilian, Afro-Cuban, Funk/Rock/Pop and Modern Jazz. Applicants are also expected to exhibit excellent sight reading skills.

Preliminary Requirements/Audition Process

Resumes and MP3 recordings must be received by **30 June 2020.** Applicants who are considered qualified for the live audition will be contacted by The USAF Band auditions team and will receive an audition invitation letter. All invited candidates must be prepared to meet Air Force maximum allowable weight standards. Please send a one page resume and preliminary recording with the requirements listed below:

1. Required excerpts:

- A) "Tip Toe" soli (letter G to letter J) attached PDF, Qtr note=144
- B) "Too Little Time" *in Glenn Miller style (pickup to "1" to measure 25)- attached PDF, Qtr note=78
- C) "I Love You" soli (measure 236 to 259) attached PDF, Qtr note=220)

2. Provide a recorded example of tunes in the styles listed below, preferably with accompaniment. The total time for all 3 tunes should not exceed 15 min. You may fade in/out to keep excerpts within the appropriate time limits.

- A) "Cherokee" in Bb, Qtr note=260 or above. (include solo choruses)
- B) 2 more tunes of choice in contrasting styles with melody and solo on each.

Electronic resumes must be received as a pdf or word doc (no cloud storage/file sharing links such as Google Docs or Dropbox).




