All invited candidates must be prepared to meet Air Force maximum allowable weight standards. Please send a one page resume and preliminary recording with the requirements listed below:

- Strauss: Concerto in E Major, Opus 11 opening fanfare, mm. 28-64
- Bach: Mass in B Minor beginning through m. 15
- Brahms: Symphony No. 1 Mvt II one before E through F
- Strauss: Till Eulenspiegel opening 1
- Tchaikovsky: Symphony No. 5 Mvt II beginning through m. 28




















Shostakovich: Symphony No. 5: 3 after 17 through 1 after 21




