Applicant must demonstrate strong, versatile abilities in the following areas:

- Extensive vocal repertoire covering all popular musical styles, including Rock, Pop, Country, R&B, and Motown. Knowledge must span from the 60's to present day.
- Strong "Fronting" capabilities; ability to lead a pop group on both large and small stages. Must demonstrate a dynamic performance personality!
- Additional instrument capabilities (e.g. guitar, piano, etc) are a plus. Please demonstrate if possible.
- Ability to read music and possess a general knowledge of music theory.

OPTION 1:

Attend an in-person preliminary audition in Nashville, TN, on **August 28, 2018**, or New York City, NY, on **August 31, 2018**. Please be prepared to perform the following with a performance track, in the original keys:

- "National Anthem" - Traditional (non-contemporary styling required)

OPTION 2:

Submit resume and video recordings of the above repertoire, either with a live band or along with their respective recordings **by August 27, 2018**. No audio editing permitted. Selections should be sung in their original keys. Optional backing tracks:

Electronic resumes must be received as a PDF file. Resume file names should be labeled *last name, first name*, and resume content must include name, phone number, and email address. Google Drive or Dropbox linked submissions preferred.

Optional:

Provide up to 4 minutes of audio and/or video(s) of choice that demonstrates applicant's strongest attributes.

Applicants who are considered qualified for the live final audition rounds in Washington, D.C. will be contacted by The USAF Band auditions team. Once approved by the recruiter, applicants will receive an audition invitation letter. All invited candidates must be below Air Force maximum allowable weight standards.

Live Final Audition Requirements:

Final rounds of the audition will be held **October 9, 2018** at Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling, Washington, D.C. A live audition repertoire list will be provided to those selected and invited to the final rounds.
