The Air Force Strings is the official string ensemble of the United States Air Force. Stationed at Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling in Washington, D.C., it is one of six musical ensembles that form The U.S. Air Force Band. The Air Force Strings consists of 18 active-duty musicians performing a wide range of musical styles, from classical symphonic selections and Broadway show tunes to classic rock, bluegrass, and patriotic compositions. The ensemble has entertained audiences at high-level military and government events in a formation known as the Strolling Strings since the time of President Eisenhower. Providing a multi-dimensional experience, the instrumentalists surround the audience performing from memory without a conductor's aid.

On other occasions, the Air Force Strings performs chamber and symphonic concerts often with other musicians from within The U.S. Air Force Band. Additionally, the ensemble's members appear regularly at military and civilian ceremonial functions, education outreach events, and concerts in the metropolitan Washington, D.C., area. The Air Force Strings' wide-ranging flexibility allows the ensemble to provide the highest caliber of musical support for any occasion.

- All applicants must meet basic enlistment standards for the U.S. Air Force Strings:
 - Age 18-41 at the time of the audition
 - Currently hold U.S. Citizenship or Green Card.
 - Meet height/weight, medical, financial, and legal requirements.









