The weekend culminates in a live streamed public performance with The U.S. Air Force Concert Band on Saturday, Feb. 2 at 8 p.m. at the Rachel M. Schlesinger Concert Hall and Arts Center, Alexandria, Virginia.

Participants are sure to enjoy this once-in-a-lifetime musical experience. The Symposium is free—no tuition or fees. Lodging will be provided, however, the selected attendees are responsible for their own transportation.
