This musical audition will be conducted in two parts: (1) an initial screening and selection by pre-recorded submissions and (2) a live audition for those selected from the initial screening. Details concerning the pre-screening submission are attached. Please look over the requirements carefully to determine if you are prepared to audition at this time. The following information outlines important dates and requirements.

16 Feb 2025 – Deadline for receipt of all musical pre-screening materials
1 Apr 2025 – Notification of pre-screening results sent by email
29 Apr 2025 – Live audition at Langley Air Force Base, Hampton, VA

In addition to passing the musical audition, applicants must meet all Air Force age, weight, medical, financial, legal, and citizenship requirements. Many of your initial questions concerning the USAF enlisted military experience can be answered at https://www.airforce.com/. If you are invited to the live audition, we recommend you meet with an official Air Force recruiter to help determine any potentially disqualifying conditions. The audition coordinator can assist with this process and provide further instructions.

Qualified applicants may be assigned to any USAF Regional Band, depending on the greatest need of the Air Force. Air Force Regional Bands are located at the following Air Force Bases: Langley, Wright-Patterson, Scott, Offutt, Lackland, Travis, Ramstein, Hickam and Yokota.

a. Solo: choose one solo from the following (or select a comparable solo work)

i. Vaughan Williams: Concerto for Bass Tuba, mvt 1

ii. Ziek: Concerto for Tuba & Wind Ensemble

iii. Barnes: Tuba Concerto, mvt 1 or 3

iv. Koetsier: Tuba Concertino, mvt 1 or 3

b. Excerpts: submit 5 excerpts showcasing a variety of styles. Suggested excerpts include, but are not limited to:

i. Grainger/Fennell: Lincolnshire Posy "Rufford Park Poachers", pickup to 51 -64 (lower octave)

ii. Revueltas: Sensemaya

iii. V. Williams: Toccata Marziale, opening to one bar after 5 (lower octave)

iv. Grantham: J'ai Ete Au Bal, pickup to 116 – 140

v. Holst: First Suite in E flat, Chaconne, first 9 measures and pickup to B - C (upper

octave)

vi. Bernstein: Symphonic Dance Music from West Side Story, Fugue, 2 mm before 54 to 3 mm after 64

vii. Hindemith: Symphony in B flat, Mvt 1, I – K and mm 203 - 209

Please submit audio recordings (MP3 files preferred) only. Please include name and selection title in each file name (Last, First_Selection Title). Submit recordings via cloud sharing services such as Google Drive (preferred), Dropbox, etc. Please ensure all files are accessible for viewing/download.
